4. 310 Emergency Applications:

Cause for Emergency Action: A tree located against an established rip-rap embankment that supports the Ousel Falls trail fell in late April dislodging the rip-rap on the bank. Rising water levels have allowed water to undermine the rip-rap and the trail.
Emergency Action Taken: Large rock sourced from the surrounding trailside and adjacent hill slope as well as salvageable dislodged rip-rap has been moved by hand and placed against the bank as temporary protection until equipment is able to reach the site.
Emergency Action Date: 05/01/2018
Additional Emergency Action: As the site become accessible to machinery, a mini excavator will be used to cut the bank to vertical in order to place a 3 yard gabion basket (3' x 3' x 9') to create a durable foundation for the trail surface. Additional rip-rap will be placed between the gabion basket and water line.
Inspection Recommendations: Approval as proposed
Inspection Comments: Proposed emergency action is appropriate to address current trail damage. A more complete design for repairs would be submitted after spring runoff flows.

Bridger Creek overflow path area in Legends 2 development parallel to Boylan and just downstream from Midfield Street

Two diversions dug out with permitting and now diverting Bridger Creek overflow from development flood plain design back into Bridger Creek with potential to adversely impact downstream homes.

The work that was done will need to be discussed at the meeting as to whether it should be considered jurisdictional because it was outside the bed/banks of the stream. What should be considered is whether its jurisdictional because the work that was done is redirecting flow back to the river and affecting the banks. The consensus is that notion should be done right now during flooding but should be monitored for channel avulsion/headcutting as flows comes up in the coming weeks.

Concern about the potential impediment to stream flows this is currently causing and additional problems if the bridge gets washed away entirely or in pieces.

The west portion of the bridge support has been undermined / eroded causing that side of the structure to fall into the creek. It does not appear to be an emergency situation since the likelihood of it breaking up, flowing downstream, and plugging something else seems low since the stream is relatively small and the steel deck and beams appear to be securely fastened making one solid structure. Currently, there is debris that has accumulated on the upstream side of the bridge causing backwater and flow is going around the edge adjacent to the failed abutment. Recommended action would be to notify landowners of the situation and that the bridge will need to come out and the banks restored during low flow.
